Subject: Tflex CR200<sup>™</sup> End of Life Notification

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to unfavorable economic, we are starting the end of life process for Tflex<sup>TM</sup> CR200. This written letter is to inform you that the last purchase date will be January 1, 2021 with a last ship date of March 1, 2021. Laird is recommending the use of Tflex<sup>TM</sup> CR350 as a replacement. Tflex<sup>TM</sup> CR350 is a cure in place, dispensable, thermal material that offers improved thermal performance over Tflex<sup>TM</sup> CR200 with competitive economics.

At this time, Tflex<sup>TM</sup> CR200 may present some shelf life stability issues under certain storage conditions and therefore we are forced to shorten the shelf life from 6 months to 3 months from date of manufacture effective immediately. The issue is only seen prior to material being mixed and cured, once cured in application there are no quality issues and the material performs as designed.

As with all cure in place gap filler products, Laird recommends for customers to follow a post dispense cure check in order to verify proper mixing has occurred and no contamination in the material was realized. Please see the Tflex<sup>TM</sup> CR200 Directions for Use document for further instructions.
