1. General description

Unidirectional ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) protection diode, designed to protect one signal line from the damage caused by ESD and other transients. The device is housed in a leadless ultra small DFN1006-2 (SOD882) Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package.

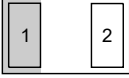


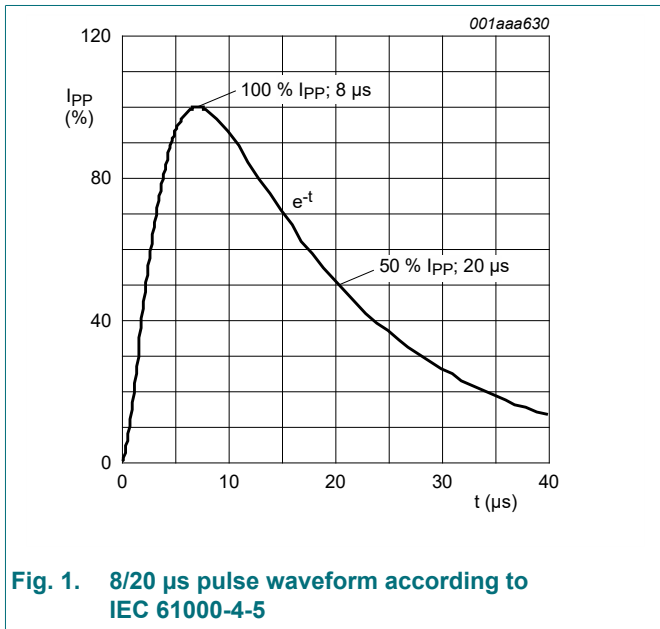


Fig. 1. 8/20 μs pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-5

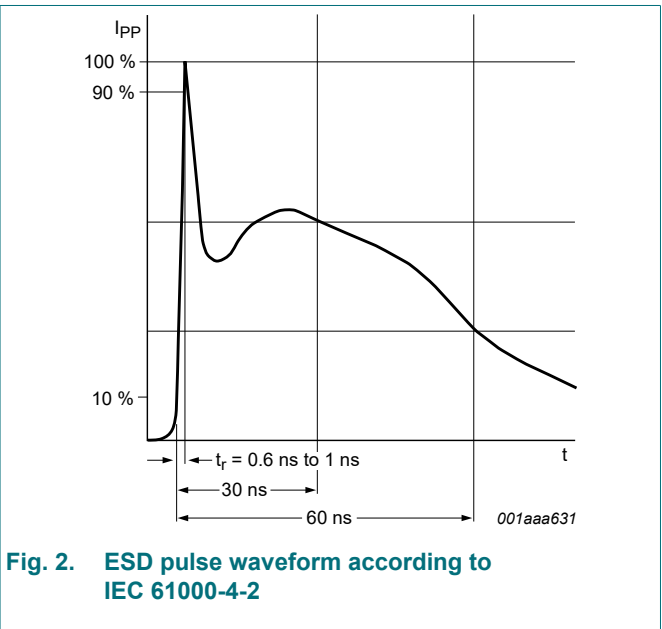


Fig. 2. ESD pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-2

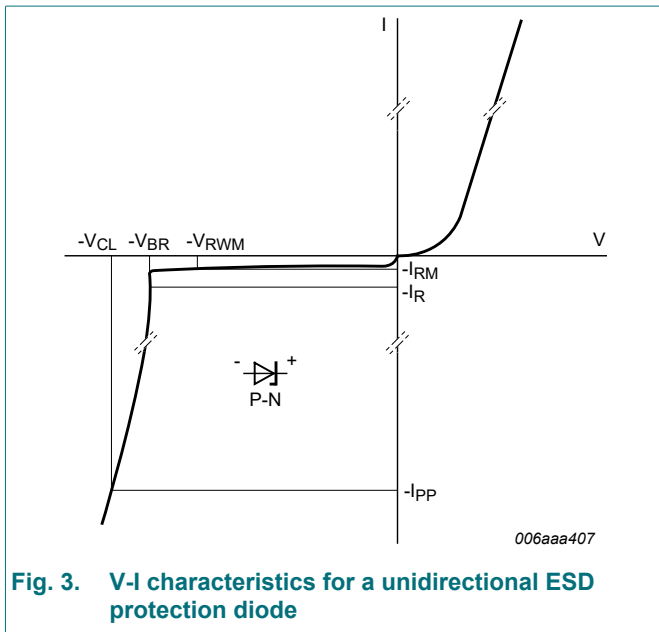


Fig. 3. V-I characteristics for a unidirectional ESD protection diode

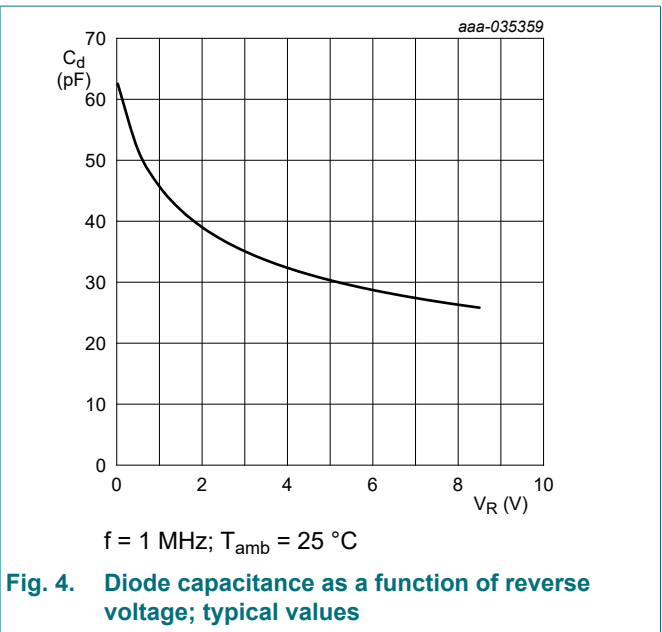
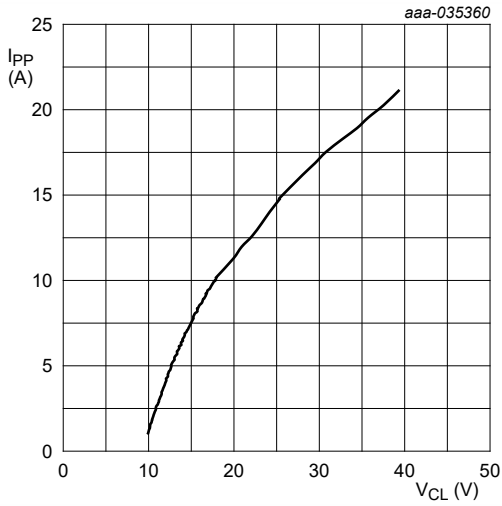
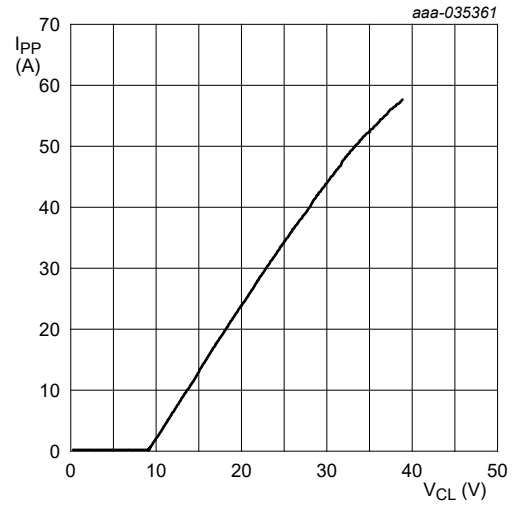


Fig. 4. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values

10. Application information

The device is designed for protection of one unidirectional data or signal line from surge pulses and ESD damage. The device is suitable on lines where the signal polarities are either positive or negative with respect to ground.

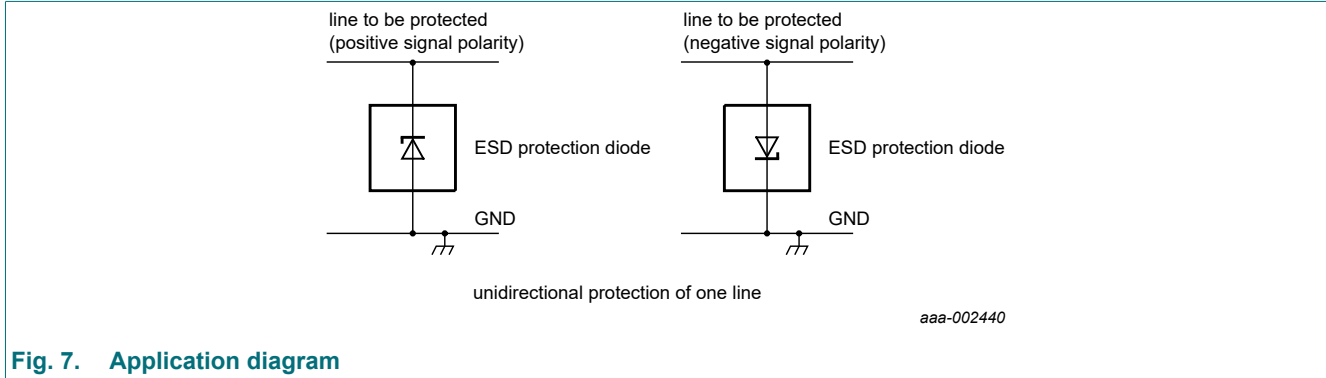


Fig. 7. Application diagram

Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.

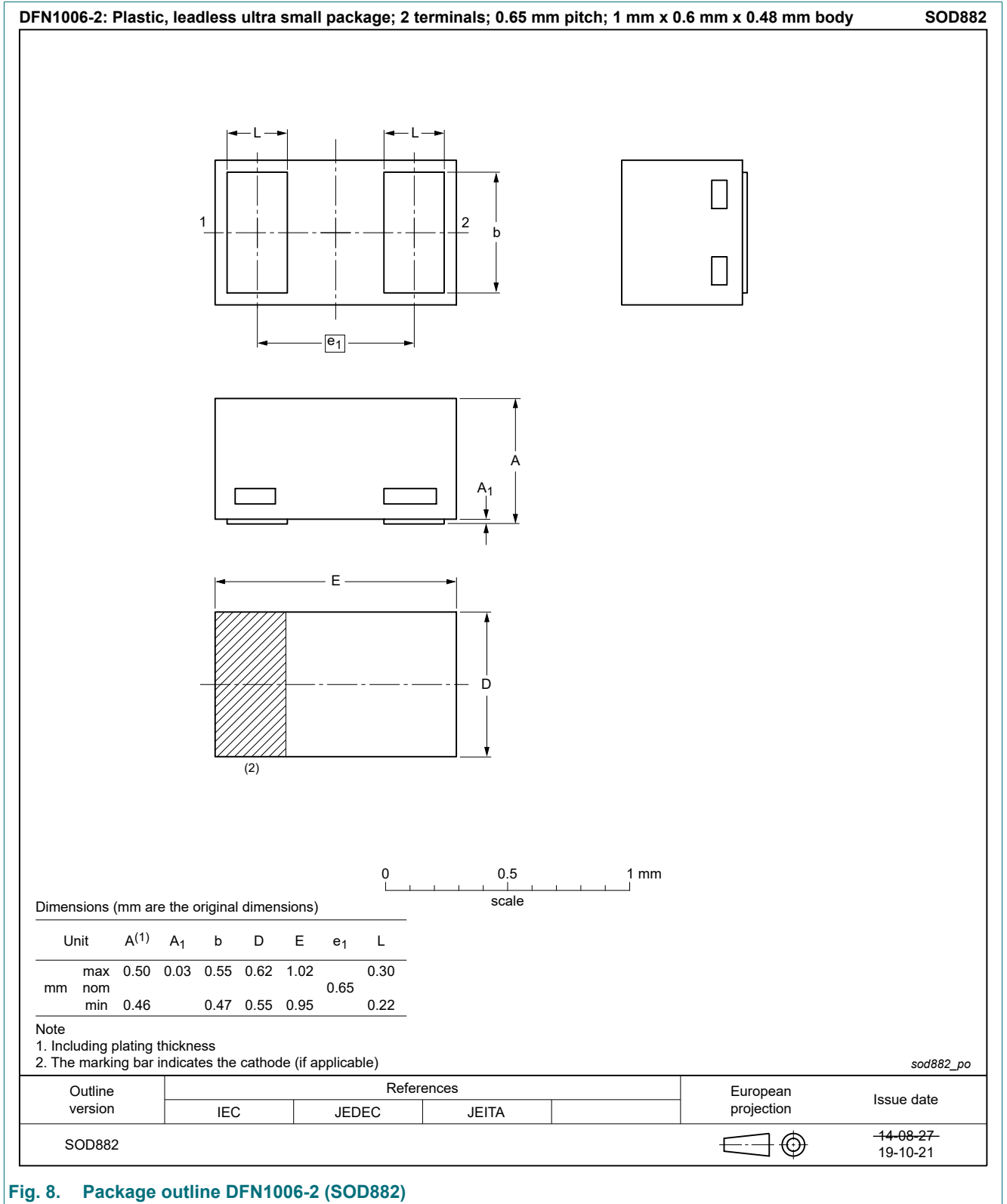


Fig. 8. Package outline DFN1006-2 (SOD882)

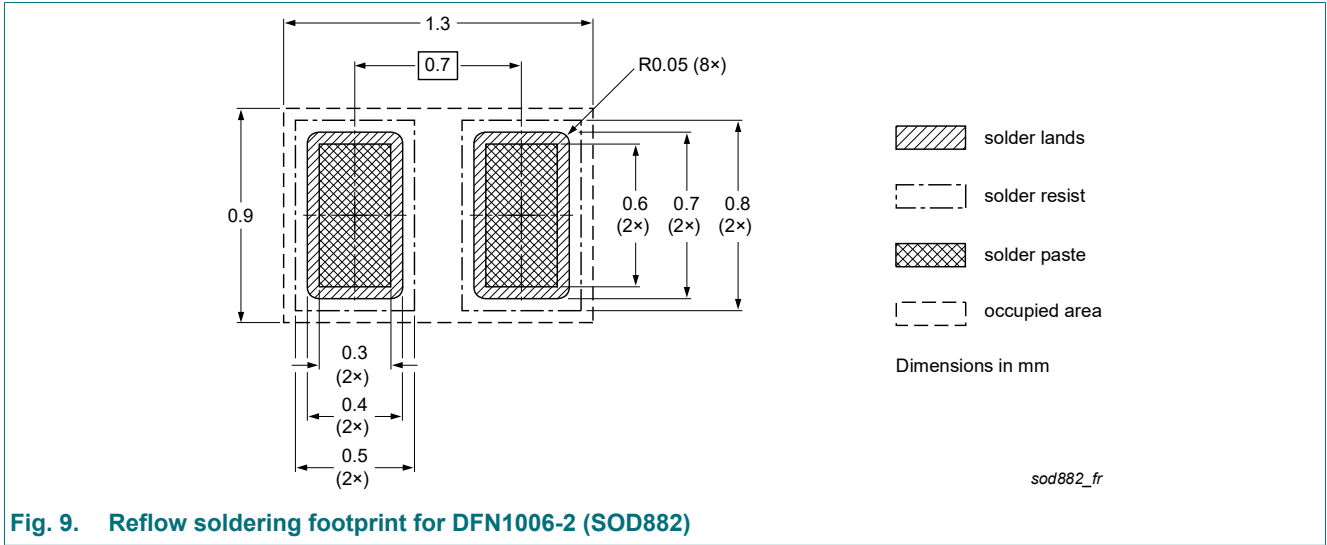


Fig. 9. Reflow soldering footprint for DFN1006-2 (SOD882)
