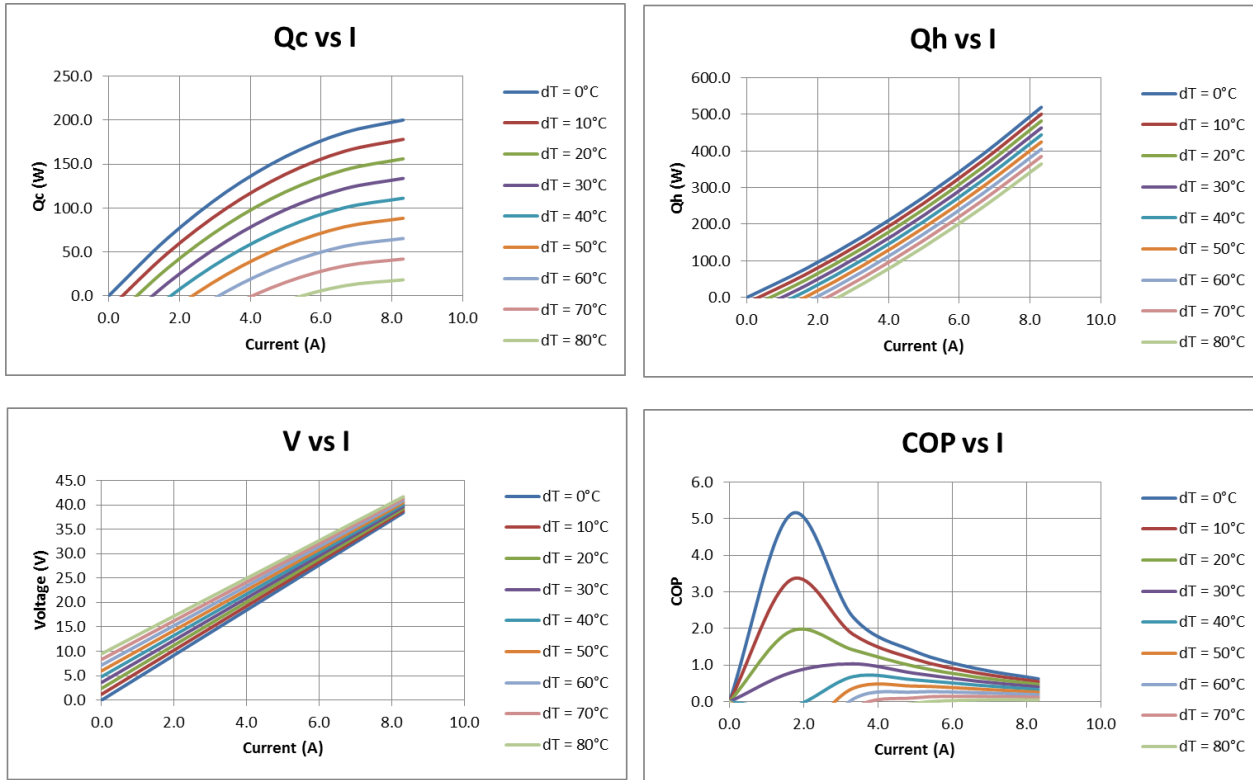

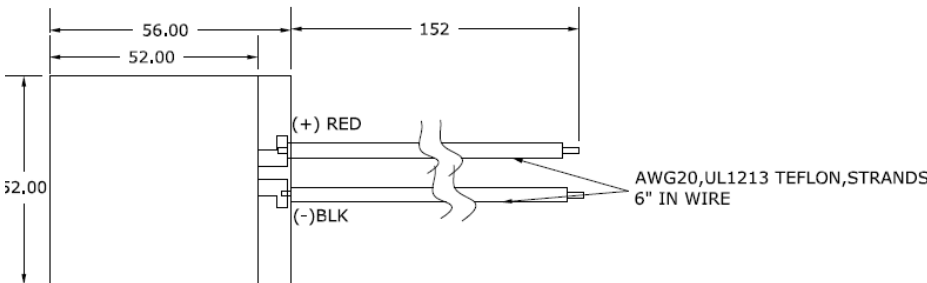

PERFORMANCE CURVES AT $T_h = 85^\circ\text{C}$



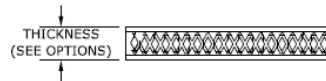
